## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- All schools are to report at the Registration Desk from 7:30 a.m. and be seated in the auditorium by 7:45 a.m. The opening ceremony will begin sharp at 8:00 a.m. Competitions will begin 8:30 a.m. onwards.
- It is mandatory for all the participants and student representatives to be in their school uniform and wear their identity cards.
- Registration on the day of the event shall be done by the student representative along with the Teacher-in-Charge.
- Once inside the school campus, no student will be allowed to leave the school premises.
- Only the official photographers will be permitted to take photographs both inside and outside the auditorium.
- No boys/male teachers/ male choreographers/male make-up artists will be allowed to enter the room allotted for girls on the day of the event. All requirements must be taken care of by the lady teacher accompanying the students. For girls' schools and co-ed schools, if the participants are accompanied by a male make-up artist or a male choreographer, the host school should be informed of the same by a letter from the Principal of the respective school (to be submitted on the day of the event at the Registration Desk. No exceptions will be made otherwise, if the letters are not received).
- For on-stage events, only the Student Representative (if required) will be allowed to be present backstage during the performance of the concerned school. No one else should be present backstage during the performance unless they are a part of the performance.
- Schools are requested to go through the schedule of the event thoroughly.
- A student can participate in a maximum of two events.
- Each school must keep a RESERVE for each event. If the participant does not reach the venue by the time mentioned, the participant will not be allowed to perform.
- Schools must make arrangements to take the junior school children back after the junior school events are over.
- No electronic gadgets will be allowed inside the auditorium except for the ones required for the events.
- Musical instruments and other required items (for different competitions) are to be brought by the participating schools. Only the drum kit will be provided by the host school.

- Any misconduct by the students or the use of vulgarity in any item will result in the disqualification of the school concerned in that particular event.
- Participating teams may be disqualified if they do not adhere to the rules and regulations of a particular event. The decision of the judges will be final and binding on all participants and should not be questioned.
- All schools should be present for the opening and the closing ceremony in the auditorium.
- Each participating school will be allotted a classroom and the concerned school will be liable for any damage done to the school's property.
- Participating schools will be responsible for their own belongings.
- Each participating school will be allotted a student escort by the host school.
- All audio and video files related to various events must be submitted in MP3 (audio) and MP4 (video) formats only. The files must be emailed to [boscotsav2026@gmail.com](mailto:boscotsav2026@gmail.com) on or before 10th July, 2026.
- Each participating school must submit a labelled pen drive containing the same audio/video files at the Registration Desk on the day of BOSCOTSAV'26.
- Participating schools must also carry a backup copy of all required audio and video files on a separate pen drive.
- The host school will not be responsible for any technical glitches during the playing of any audio/video files during the final performance of any event of BOSCOTSAV'26.
- Any additional requirements, if applicable, for any event must be communicated via email to [boscotsav2026@gmail.com](mailto:boscotsav2026@gmail.com) on or before 10th July, 2026. The email must clearly specify the name of the event along with the requirement(s) for that event.
- Participating schools will be responsible for their own belongings.
- Each participating school will be allotted a student escort by the host school.
- The official BOSCOTSAV'26 website will go live on 1st July, 2026. The online Registration Portal will open on the same day for the submission of participant details by all participating schools.
- The Registration Portal will remain active until 8th July, 2026. Schools are requested to complete all registrations and submit the participant details for all events within this period.
- Any changes to the participant list after 8th July, 2026 and before the event must be submitted via email to [boscotsav2026@gmail.com](mailto:boscotsav2026@gmail.com) by 13th July, 2026 using the Digital Change Sheet provided by the host school.

**EVENT:** Robotics Model-Making Competition.

**CLASS:** 5

**NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:** 4

There will be two teams consisting of two participants each. (2x2 = 4)

**DURATION:** 1 hour

1. Constructing the model-55 minutes
2. Presentation and Demonstration- 5 minutes

### **RULES OF THE EVENT:**

1. Models should preferably be lightweight and portable.
2. No materials will be provided; students must carry all the materials required for the event.
3. Size of the model should not exceed 3 feet.
4. Participants must complete their model within the allotted time.
5. The robot must be handmade by the students.
6. The use of coding/programming to operate the robotic model is not permitted.
7. The model may demonstrate any one functional activity (optional) such as:
  - a. Lighting an LED/bulb
  - b. Sound activation, etc.
8. The entire model, including the designing, painting, decorating, and the working mechanism (fixing the LEDs, sensors), etc. must be completed during the event within the allotted time.
9. Participants should be in their school uniform.
10. The decision of the Judge will be final and binding.

### **EVENT OVERVIEW :**

The "Intelligence" category is designed to encourage creativity, innovation, scientific thinking, and practical application of basic mechanical and electrical concepts. Participants are required to create a robot model using commonly available household or recyclable materials. The robot may demonstrate at least one simple action or movement (optional).

### **MATERIALS WHICH CAN BE USED FOR THE MODEL MAKING:**

Participants must design and create a robotic model using household, recyclable, or easily available materials such as:

1. Cardboard
2. Springs
3. Plastic bottles/caps
4. Wires
5. Switches
6. LEDs/bulbs
7. Small motors
8. Ice-cream sticks
9. Foam sheets
10. Metal scraps
11. Batteries
12. Sensors, etc.

### **RESTRICTED MATERIALS WHICH CANNOT BE USED:**

1. Ready-made robotics kits
2. Professionally manufactured robot bodies
3. High-voltage electrical components
4. Open flames or heating devices
5. Hazardous chemicals
6. Sharp or dangerous materials
7. Remote-controlled drones or large machines
8. Any unsafe electrical setup .etc

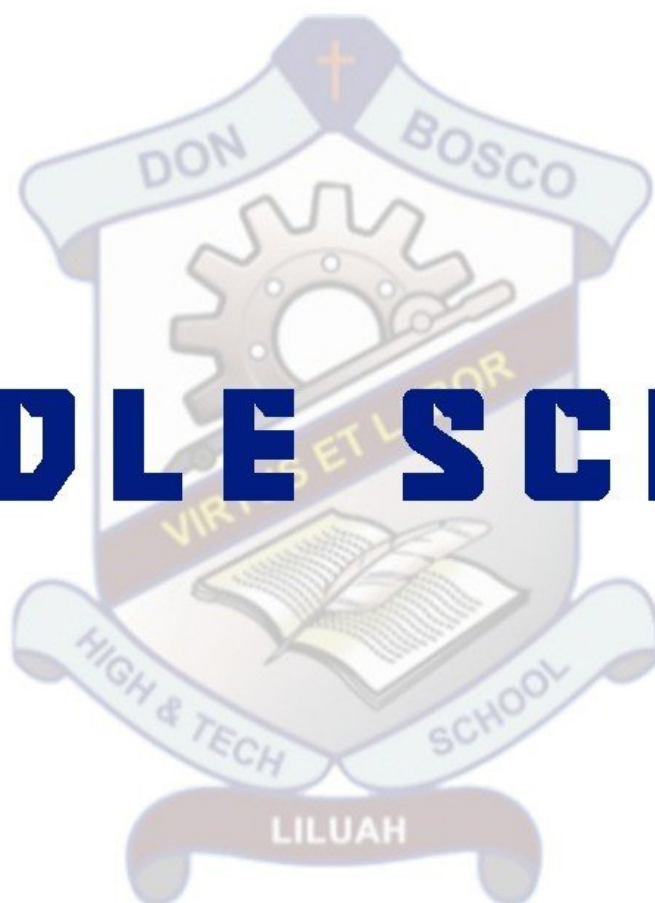

3. An 18" x 18" square mount board must be used as the base for the artwork. Participants must write their personal details on the back of the base sheet.
4. Participants must bring all the stationery and craft materials required for the event, such as coloured paper, glue, scissors, cutters, tapes, etc. No materials will be provided by the host school. Sharp objects must be handled carefully and at the participants' own risk.
5. The artwork must use only paper-based 3D techniques such as folding, layering, cutting, rolling, and pop-up structuring.
6. The artwork must be original. Pre-made models, pre-cut templates, reference materials, or ready-made parts of a model are not allowed. Acrylic paint may be used.
7. The artwork must not contain any political, offensive, or inappropriate content. Violation of this rule may result in disqualification.
8. Exceeding the time limit may result in disqualification.

8. Participants may conduct interviews but must not take direct external help in content creation.
9. Uploading or sharing content on social media during the fest is strictly prohibited.
10. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited.



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11. All content collection and final submissions (PPT + Video + Report) must be completed within the allotted time.
12. Use of unfair means will lead to immediate disqualification.
13. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
